



## Wolverton Park fees

Wolverton Park Nursery operates for 49 weeks a year, excluding bank holidays. We close for the last week of July and first week of August, as well as one week over the Christmas and New Year period. Our opening times are Monday to Friday, 07:30-18:15.

### Private Fees per month:

Please note that our private fees cover all essentials, including high-quality nappies, wipes, cow's milk, oat milk, and nutritious meals and snacks.

At Wolverton Park Nursery, we accept 15-hours & 30-hours funding. As we are open for 49 weeks a year, we have prorated the funding entitlements along with our private rates and averaged this into **12 equal monthly payments**. This is an all-inclusive option which covers additional non-funded hours, breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks, milk, nappies, ingredients for baking, forest school, yoga, food for festivals/ celebrations and all non-food consumables. The government funded 30 hours are evenly divided across 3 days per week (within term time). The same principle applies for 15 hours.

Kindly be aware that the funding covers care only, and on funded days additional charges apply for the following:

#### Key information:

- We cannot offer any refunds for sickness or holidays.
- One-off session swaps are not permitted.
- All schedule changes need one month's notice.
- We offer a 10% sibling discount to the child who is older or has fewer sessions.
- Our minimum attendance requirement is 3 full days. There are no fixed drop-off or pick-up times, allowing flexibility.
- Please note funded spaces are required to either take a Monday or Friday schedule. All conditions are subject to availability, and should you wish to spread your funded hours across another setting, please contact a member of management.
- The consumables charges apply across all 3 funded days and cannot be allocated on an ad-hoc basis. The non-consumables charges include nappies, wipes, suncreams, nappy bags and extra-curricular sessions, including Forest school, Yoga and 'The Little Bake House'.
- During the 3 weeks set closure, fees do not apply. This has already been deducted and reflected in the fee sheet above.
- Fees are billed in advance (1<sup>st</sup> of the month) with payment due within 14 days of the same working month. Invoices are calculated on a 49-week basis and divided evenly across 12 months. Fees will change the term after the child's third birthday.
- There is an upfront £325 registration fee for private hours spaces, this includes your first complete set of uniform. This is non-refundable. Spaces are not confirmed until the registration fee is paid, and contracts are signed.

#### Tax free and funding information:

If you meet the eligibility criteria, your child may qualify for funded childcare each week. To apply, visit the government website for full details. Parents are responsible for completing the application, supplying the nursery with their eligibility code, and providing any necessary information.

Wolverton Park Nursery also accepts Tax free childcare payments, Tax-Free Childcare is a payment option that helps reduce childcare costs, offering substantial monthly savings. It can be used alongside both 15- and 30-hour funding. Full eligibility details can be found on the government website. As a parent, you are responsible for providing us with your child's Tax-Free Childcare code and ensuring that fees are paid at least five working days before the due date to allow time for processing.

All charges are clearly communicated to parents/carers in advance. Please note, parents/carers may opt to provide their child's meals and some consumables themselves to avoid additional charges. Please see our 'Nutrition and Mealtime Policy' for more information on bringing food into the nursery. Please note, there are options for parents to build their own packages. Please speak to the funding manager to discuss further options.
